Seeing Sound

Come make music! This year's music arts camp highlights exploration in making instruments, kinetic sculptures and sound installations. Musicians from Greensboro will present different techniques used in making music and sound come alive!

Podcast Production

Produce a podcast! We will take a look at different models for organizing podcasts. Students will focus on interviewing skills, researching subject matter and collaboration using recording software to produce a podcast!

Visual Language of Food

Whats on the Menu? For this week's camp, students will take on the diverse jobs needed to run a restaurant! From designing the space to exploring the visual language of food; campers will work with local chefs to experiment with food and taste to create a delicious menu.

Text that Talks

Tell your story! The week will focus on different kinds of storytelling through the use of improvisation, prompt writing exercises and text based visual art. Students will hone skills and share their work in a supportive atmosphere. Along with writing, students will also learn pamphlet, zine and book making skills so that the writing has a place to live and appear visually.

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Exhibition Exploration

Make a museum! This week's camp guides students in techniques for research, curation and setting up exhibit space. What would you put in your museum?

Movement

Let's Move! This week students will experience drawing through various forms of movement from dance to martial arts. We will participate in bodily kinesthetic activities while focusing on mark making relationships and sensory awareness.

Furniture Design

Come Sketch, Design and Make....Functional Sculpture! We will focus on finding creative solutions to change existing garments and furniture into usable sculpture.

Game Design

Shall we play a game?! We will use models of game play and basic aesthetic principles to create various games for entertainment, exercise and experimental purposes. Students will focus on basic elements of design--line, shape, color, etc. to engineer fun and creativity!

PAYMENT & REFUND POLICIES

All payments are due at the time of registration. I hereby authorize Greensboro Project Space (GPS) to charge my bank, or credit card account. I represent and warrant that if I am purchasing services from GPS that any credit or bank account draft (ACH Draft) information I supply is true and complete, charges incurred by me will be honored by my credit card company or financial institution, and I will pay the charges incurred by me at the accepted prices, including any applicable fees, penalties and taxes.

I accept that GPS offers NO refunds. In the event of illness, GPS will allow me to use my tuition payment for a future class within one (1) year. I acknowledge and accept that GPS prohibits participants with a communicable illness to attend class, and ill participants will be sent home.

PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT, RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK.

Because participation in certain classes may be dangerous, GPS requires all participants to assume all risk. In consideration of the services of GPS, their owners, agents, officers, contractors, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on their behalf (hereinafter collectively referred to as "GPS"), I hereby agree to release, indemnify, and discharge GPS, on behalf of myself, my parents, my spouse, my children, my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and estate as follows:

I acknowledge that my participation in various disciplines entails known and unanticipated risks that could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death or damage to me, to property, or to third parties. I understand that such risks cannot be completely eliminated. The risks include, among other things: bites, slips and falls; falling from equipment; pinches, scrapes, twists and jolts that could result in puncture, scratches, bruises, sprains, lacerations, fractures, concussions, or even more severe life threatening hazards; strains, cuts, bruises, muscle soreness, musculoskeletal injuries including head, neck, and back; injuries to internal organs, the negligence of other people; my own physical condition; and the risk of emotional and psychological injuries or physical damage associated with any activities.

In case of any emergency, I consent and hereby give my permission granting GPS the authority to obtain medical assistance and treatment as they deem necessary. I give my express permission and consent for medical treatment to be administered should illness or injury occur while in attendance at or while participating in any activity associated with GPS and to do so WITHOUT HAVING TO WAIT UNTIL I AM CONTACTED. I understand that neither GPS, its owners, officers, agents, contractors, employees or servants shall be responsible for any medical expenses incurred on behalf of the participant, and that I am responsible for all payments of medical expenses so incurred. I agree to reimburse GPS for any cost it may incur to provide medical assistance and treatment.

Furthermore, GPS contractors and employees have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety, but they are not infallible. They may be unaware of a participant’s fitness or abilities. They may misjudge the environmental conditions. They may give incomplete warnings or instructions, and the equipment being used might malfunction.

I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume all of the risks existing in this activity. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary, and I elect to participate in spite of the risks. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless GPS from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action, which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity or my use of GPS’s equipment or facilities, including any such claims which allege negligent acts or omissions of GPS. Should GPS or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney’s fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs. I certify that I have adequate INSURANCE to cover any injury or damage I may cause or suffer while participating, or else I agree to bear the costs of any and all claims, actions, demands or rights to monetary judgments whatsoever arising from any and all injury or physical harm which may arise from the rendering of such judgments, including specifically those that may arise out of, or be occasioned by, tis officers, agents, employees, contractors or servants involved in the rendering of such judgments.
