LET'S BEAT THE HEAT IN 2025!

Kitten season is almost here, and with it comes the potential for explosive growth in the cat population! Did you know that cats can start breeding as early as 4 - 5 months old and may have up to three litters a year? Without spay/neuter intervention, the cat population can spiral out of control.

Over the past four years, we've helped facilitate around 13,607 spay/neuter surgeries, but thanks to your incredible support, we set a new record of 3,925 surgeries just last year! Of those, 1,411 were TNR (trap-neuter-return), which is colony crucial for stabilizing feral populations. How amazing is that? These results wouldn't be possible without YOU!

Beat the Heat!

Spay/Neuter NOW - Before Kitten Season



- Cats have a 63-day (9 week) gestation period.
- Spring kittens are being conceived right now!
- Prevention is key with Trap-Neuter-Return and Spay/Neuter of cats you are feeding!

However, this vital work comes with a cost. In 2023, we spent \$205,361 on spay/neuter efforts, and in 2024, with rising expenses and a record number of surgeries, that cost jumped to \$213,498. While every dollar spent goes directly toward controlling the cat population, increasing prices are putting significant pressure on our budget.

Thankfully, we have two incredible matching fund partners: Jackie Zehring and Rose Zafren (RZ Foundation) who have been champions of our Beat the Heat campaign for many years! Their generosity is a lifeline for us, and we are so deeply grateful. A thousand 'thank yous' to them!

This year, Jackie Zehring and the RZ Foundation have pledged \$15,000 each in matching funds! That means we already have \$30,000 in matching money on the table! Last year, you, our amazing community of supporters, helped us raise \$50,088 in community support for Beat the Heat. We're hoping to match last year's success and raise \$50,000 in community support, which, with the matching funds, would bring us to at least \$80,000, helping us continue our vital work to prevent an overpopulation crisis.





Cat's Cradle of the Shenandoah Valley, Inc. has received a \$20,000 grant from PetSmart Charities to help prepare more homeless cats in the Shenandoah Valley for adoption. Some four million pets find themselves in U.S. shelters each year. In partnership with PetSmart Charities, Cat's Cradle will bring adoptable pets to two PetSmart locations in support of National Adoption Week, taking place March 29th at the Waynesboro and Harrisonburg PetSmart stores. With the help of this grant, the organization will offer cats and kittens for adoption fully vetted and spayed/neutered.

"The support from Petco love is so needed in our community! This grant will allow us to help thirty-three community cats and their caretakers to receive Trap, Neuter, Return (TNR) services. There is a direct impact when you perform TNR in communities you see reduced intake at our local shelter," said Sherri Heishman, Cat's Cradle Executive Director. Since its founding in 1999, Petco Love has invested nearly \$400 million in adoption and other lifesaving efforts.
